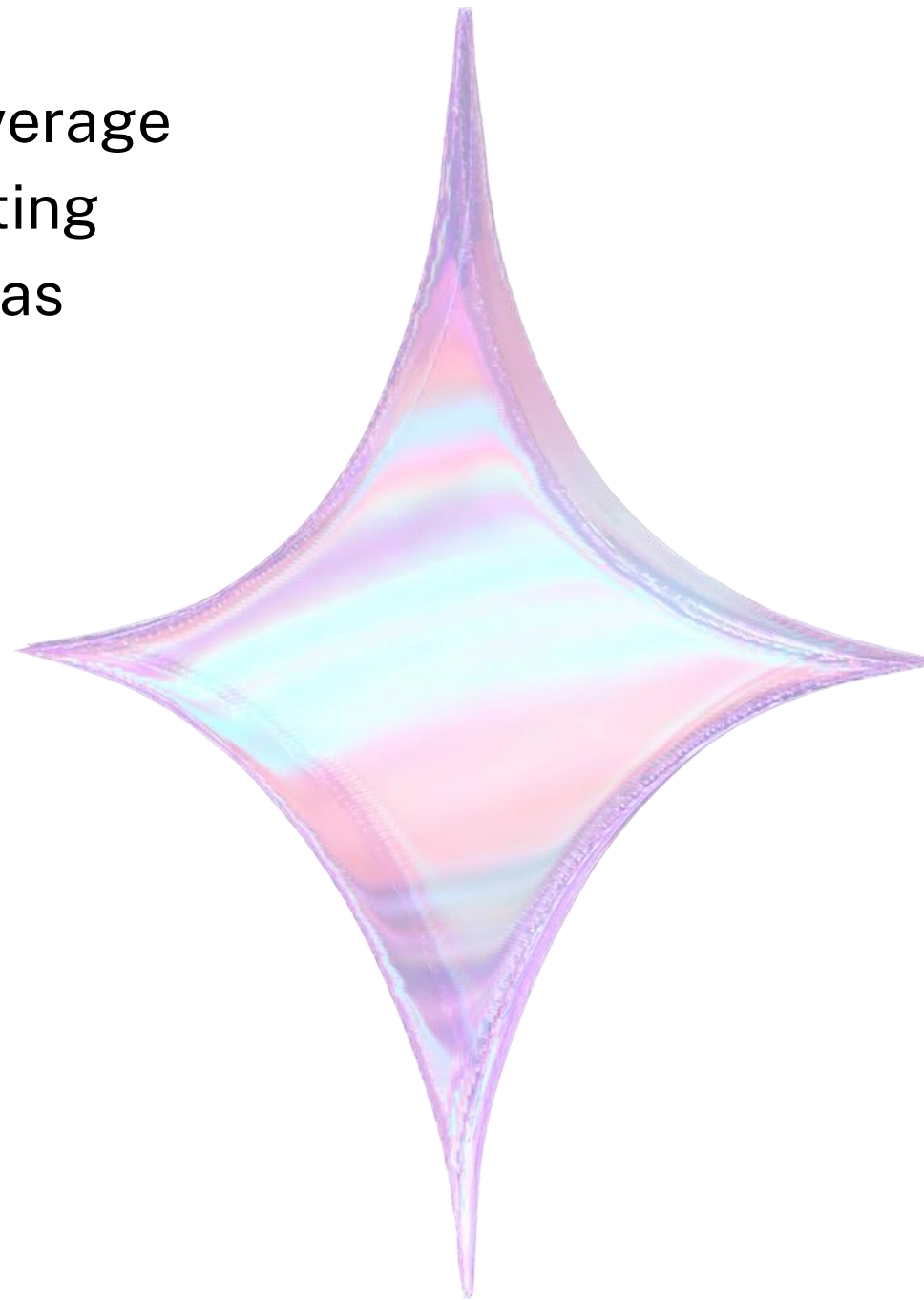

# Visual Media Crossroads

Visual professionals want to leverage copyright to protect their existing work from being used unfairly as training data for AI models.



Professionals want to use generative AI tools as part of the creative process and safely commercialize the work created with AI.

# Regulatory Framework Evolution

## ***EU***

### **Law in Effect**

#### EU Copyright Directive (2019)

- Text and Data Mining (TDM) Exception (Art 4)
- Opt-out Right (Art 4(3)), “in an appropriate manner, such as machine-readable means...”

#### EU AI Act (effective 8/2025)

- Key Transparency provisions requiring GPAI providers to:
  - Retain a summary of content used for training
  - Design and implement systems to prevent infringing content and label AI generated content

## ***US***

### **Federal Guidance**

#### US Copyright Office Guidance (2023)

- Must disclose AI use in creation process to obtain copyright

### **State Legislation**

#### Prioritize disclosure and transparency as a core principle

- Most states have introduced or enacted AI legislation
- At least 8 states have enacted AI laws with transparency provisions

# Transparency & Standards Convergence

**Metadata can be used for IP protection and can enable trusted and transparent distribution of AI generated work**

- Indicate AI opt-out preferences
- Identify AI generated or manipulated content
- Enable provenance verification



# Protection Tools & Strategies

## 01 ***Leverage Metadata Standards***

- Preserve metadata as a rule
- Embrace transparency and maintain audit trail
- Start signing content using C2PA (see IIPC Guide)



## 02 ***Unauthorized Scraping & Licensing***

- EU TDM copyright exception opt-out
- IIPC List of 12 technical suggestions to stop scraping
- Automated licensing (really simple licensing (RSL))

## 03 ***Legal & Technical Combinations***

- Compliance & Technical teams work together
- Consistency between legal and technical solutions



# Using AI Generated Content Responsibly

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## Be Transparent

- Disclose AI generated content and the AI tools used for creation or edits
- Be honest about content sources

## Think about the context

- Editorial vs creative use
- Commercial use
- When to go beyond metadata

## Demand Transparency

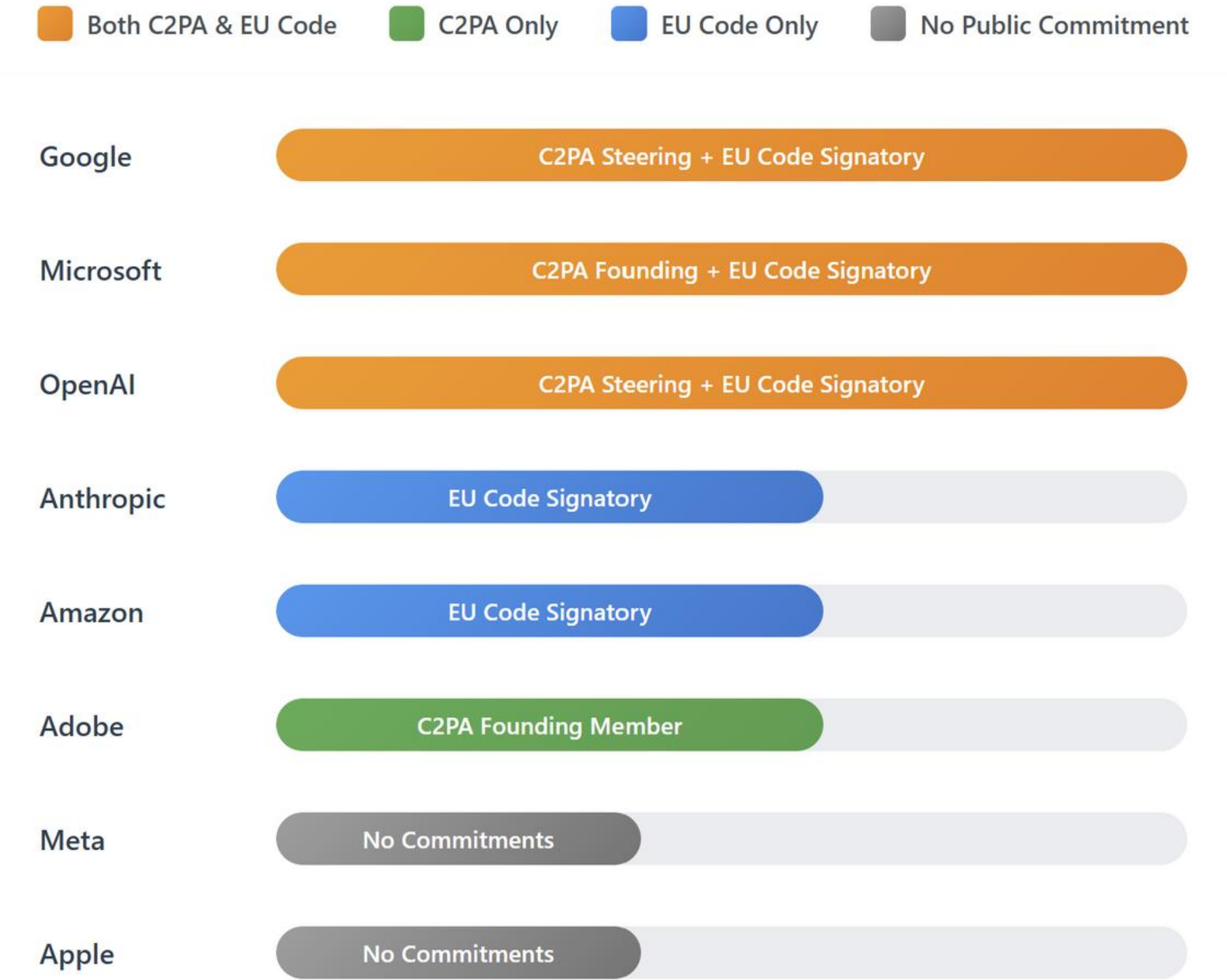
- Use commercially safe generative models
- Use GPAI tools from developers who have agreed to the EU code of practice

# Industry Outlook & Next Steps

## Transparency as competitive advantage

- Major GPAI model developers have agreed to voluntary commitments under EU AI Act Code of Practice
- C2PA Standard is being broadly adopted.
