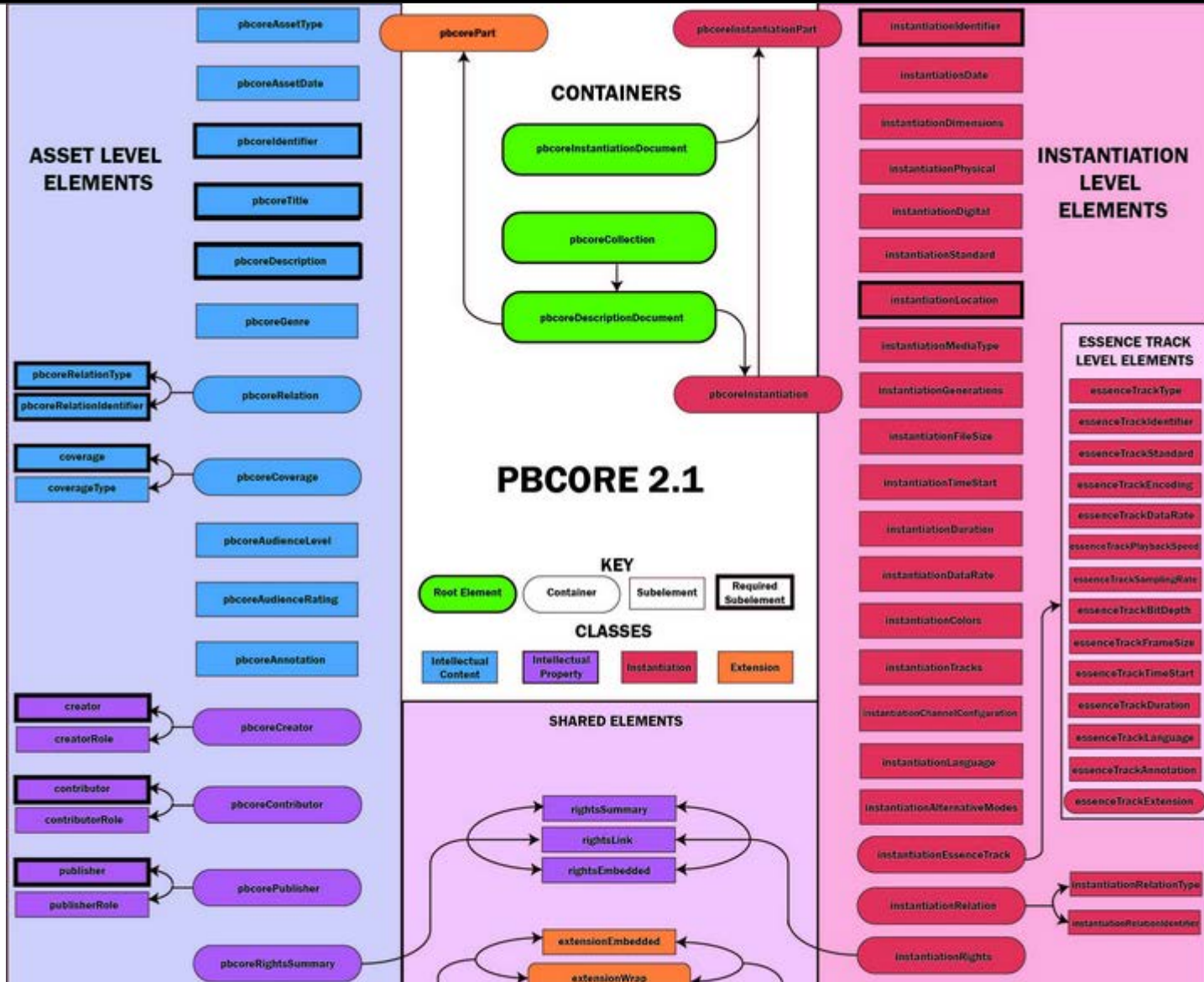
**PBCore can be used as:**

- **A guideline for cataloging or describing audiovisual content**
- **A model for building custom databases/applications**

- **A data model for a configurable collection management system**

- **An exchange (import or export) mechanism between applications**

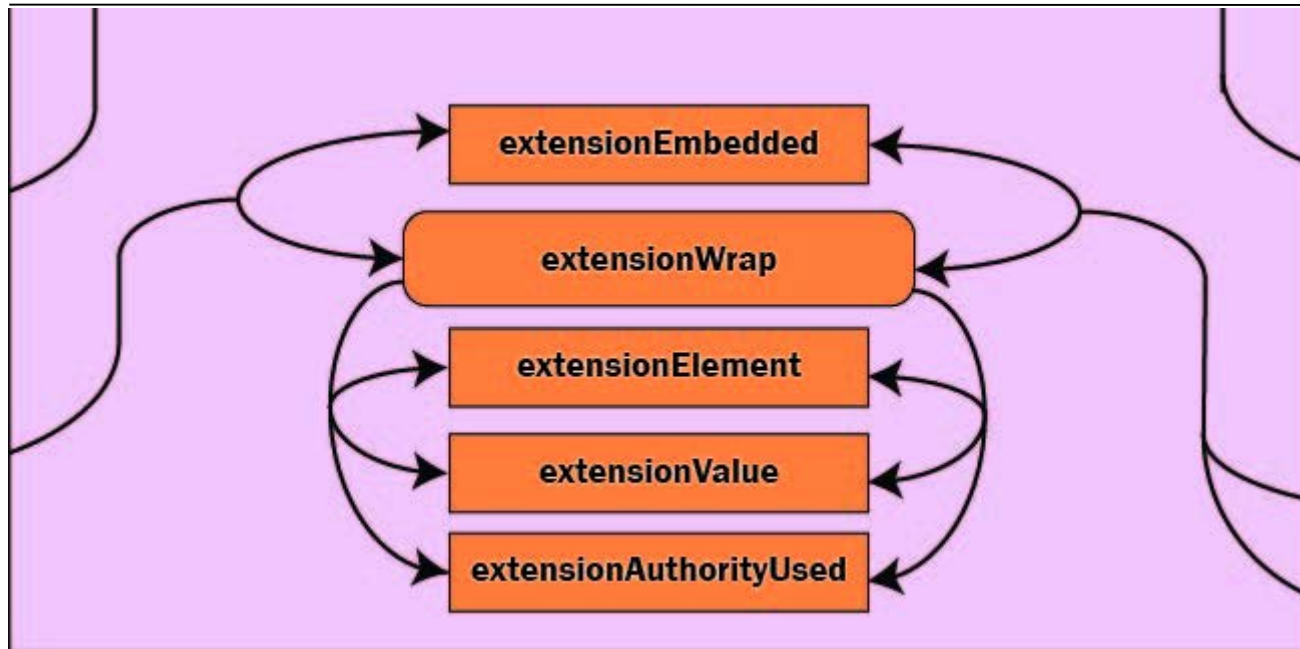

## pbcoreTitle

**pbcoreTitle** is a name or label relevant to the asset.

Best practices: There may be many types of titles an asset may have, such as a series title, episode title, segment title, or project title, therefore the element is repeatable.

pbcoreInstantiation can be contained within the elements [pbcoreDescriptionDocument](#) or [pbcorePart](#).

Usage: *required, repeatable.*

## Attributes

- **titleType** – *optional*. Use the attribute titleType to indicate the type of title being assigned to the asset, such as series title, episode title or project title.
- **titleTypeSource** – *optional*. Attribute titleTypeSource provides the name of the authority used to declare data value of the titleType attribute. This might be the name of a controlled vocabulary, namespace or authority list, such as the official PBCore vocabulary. We recommend a consistent and human readable use.
- **titleTypeRef** – *optional*. Use attribute titleTypeRef to supply a source's URI for the value of the attribute titleTypeSource. Attribute titleTypeRef can be used to point to a term in a controlled vocabulary, or a URI associated with a source.
- **titleTypeVersion** – *optional*. Attribute titleTypeVersion identifies any version information about the authority or convention used to express data of this element.
- **titleTypeAnnotation** – *optional*. Attribute titleTypeAnnotation includes narrative information intended to clarify the nature of data used in

For digital storage carriers that contain file-based media, such as data CDs, LTO tapes or hard drives, use instantiationDigital to convey the mime type of the file instead of describing the carrier.</p>

Term	Proposed Definition
1 inch videotape	An open reel analog videotape format. Types of 1 inch videotape include MVC-10, PI-3V, EV-200, EL-3400, IVC-700, IVC-800, IVC-900, UV-340, EV-210, BVH-1000, HDV-1000, HDD-1000, SMPTE Type A, SMPTE Type B, and SMPTE Type C. More specific format information can be included in an annotation.
1/2 inch videotape	An open reel analog videotape format. May also be known as helical scan tape. Types of 1/2 inch video tape include: CV, EIAJ Type 1, Hawkeye, Recam, V200, and VCR. More specific format information can be appended to the term in an annotation.
1/4 inch videotape	An open reel analog videotape format. May also be known as Akai.
2 inch videotape	An open reel analog videotape format. Types of 2 inch videotape include: Quadruplex, Octaplex, VR-1500, VR-1600, IVC-9000, Helical SV-201, and ACR 25. More specific format information can be included in an annotation.
Betacam	A cassette-based 1/2-inch analog videotape format. Types of Betacam also include the higher-quality Betacam SP. More specific format information can be included in an annotation.
